## SENSE Charter School by Kate Voss



SENSE Charter School is proud to announce the arrival of ten new additions to our school!

The second grade classes have been working with a chick-hatching project the past couple of weeks. This project is designed to teach students about life cycles and to help students realize that they can learn a lot about chickens through close observation. They also should come to understand that it is important to learn about the special needs of eggs and chicks in order to take care of them. They placed fertilized chicken eggs in classroom incubators until they hatched. The students enjoyed watching the hatching eggs and seeing the chicks emerge from their shells. "This hands-on learning experience was extremely rewarding and taught our students how to responsibly care for living creatures", said second grade teacher, Shannon Martin.

All ten eggs hatched and we had ten healthy and adorable chicks. At the end of the unit, all chicks went to a free-range farm where they will live and thrive. SENSE now has "chicken fever" and will be hatching, raising, and caring for a flock of chickens in their new chicken coop starting in the fall.

The equipment and feed for this project was provided through funding by Southeast Community Services.
