Letter from the President

Have you ever wondered about the orange "Public Hearing" signs or been interested in new development in Bates-Hendricks? Try joining our Land Use Committee!

The orange signs indicate that a property will have a hearing in front of one of a few City Boards to gain approval for variances needed for the project or a change in zoning. The reason that development may need a variance or change in zoning relates to some part of the project that does not meet a City ordinance.

When a variance is needed or a change in zoning is requested, then the entity needing the variance or change is required to notify the neighborhood association. The Bates-Hendricks Land Use committee then discusses the request(s) at our monthly meetings which are typically held over Zoom.

We often meet with the neighbors or developers that made the request. We share our thoughts as a committee, determine if we need to address the request, and if we will support or oppose the project.



Not all development in the neighborhood needs a variance or change in zoning so the Land Use committee does not get notified about all construction in Bates-Hendricks. But we do get a chance to openly share our opinions and influence development in our neighborhood when there is an opportunity. It's a great way to connect with others that are passionate about the neighborhood and to be aware of changes in the neighborhood.


